Motion: to accept the Treasurer's report made by Mat and seconded by Larry. Passed unanimously.

Communications:

We received NHSA's Sno-Traveler Magazine, bank statements, and a letter from Allied Insurance asking if our club would like to opt-in to their volunteer accident medical expense insurance plan for \$300. The plan will only be effective if a total of 60 snowmobile clubs sign up for it.

Motion: to cut a check for \$300 to Allied Insurance if this plan becomes a reality as made by Larry and seconded by Matt. Passed unanimously.

Also, Claremont Savings Bank Foundation is offering grants from \$500 to \$5,000, deadline being May 11th. Babs will find out what the rules are for these grants. Some thoughts were offered as to what we could apply for that would not conflict with our grants to NHSA. Other ideas should be sent to Terry.

Babs and Bill will have a summer get-together for the club again this year sometime in late June or early July. They will be having a pig roast for all members, and anyone having other plans during this time, but would like to attend, should let them know ASAP what days they are not available. Terry said that Grinaskis, who have a place on the lake, might be willing to host something for the club some time during the late summer.

A final note, we now have a total of 88 memberships to end this season – 50 Individuals and 38 Families.

Committee Reports:

Fundraising:

Matt will host Old Home Days again this year, and he had a few food items for other members to pick up.

Trail Report:

A long list of items, including many bridge repairs, were discussed for summer projects. Terry will organize the list for importance. Work-bees will be set up once the weather turns warmer.

Old Business:

Earl and his wife, Brandy, put together 10 beautiful "thank-you" baskets for people who own the land under our trails, along with help from Eric. Bob Brown was given his basket as he was present in the fire house at this time. This fall, another 10 baskets will be put together. This is an effort to show our appreciation for land owners' continued cooperation.

Also, Northern Lights (Eric Callum) made 3 signs for the club announcing that the Unity Store was our official Lost and Found location, along with their phone number. They will be hung in strategic locations along the trails and warming huts.

New Business:

Terry asked about dedicating some of our main bridges to club members who have passed away, and all members present thought it was a great idea. Northern Lights will make signs as the names are assigned to the bridges.
