*Fundraising:*

- **Grooming Team:** Scott Keniston & Chris Sheerman received certificates for completing the *Groomer Operator Safety Awareness Program*, and Adam Ferland is working on his certification. Congratulations for their efforts, and a big thank you to them and the entire grooming team
- **Ride along Grooming:** Drivers, please contact the CLRSR Secretary if you would like someone to ride along with you.

*Equipment Report:*

- **ASV:** Terry Callum dropped off about 175 studs to Dave Loring for ASV track; more may be needed. Fluids & filters have been changed.
- **Tucker:** Larry LeClerc reported that the suspension is being worked over, a tie rod was replaced, and it is being given a thorough work over. The steering fluid will be replaced as well.

*Trail Report:*

- **Mueller's field:** Seven members staked & roped off over 4,000' of trail, including adding trail signs.
- Several work parties & individuals have done a great job preparing trails for the snow. A much appreciated thank you to all who helped, and continue to help!
- **Perry Mountain Hut:** Nick Taylor reported the hut is pretty much ready to go. Some wood was stacked but more is needed.

*Trail Assessments:*

- **Trail Status:** Approx. 60% of the trails have been cleared.
- **New Groomer Operators:** More are needed to help lighten the load for the existing Groomers. Completion of the *Groomer Operator Safety Awareness Program* is required, followed by ride-alongs and hands-on training with experienced club operators. Contact Terry Callum if interested.

**Old Business:**

- **Supplies for Pizza at meetings:** Gary Ross noted that the club used Unity Fire Department supplies these past 2 meetings, and questioned if we should get our own supplies.
