Fundraising:

Trail Report:

Terry asked if anyone knew of any major damage as a result of the recent rains/ice jams, and nothing additional has been spotted at this time although the trails have severely lost much of their snow. Nick said there were some huge ice chunks left on his property but not sure if any were deposited on trails.

Adam noticed a sign on a cable strung across the trail on Bill Willette's property by Gove Hill. Terry said he'd asked Willette about it as it shouldn't have been placed across the public part of the trail. Also, Adam noticed there was no wood in the Gove warming hut so he brought some in.

Larry offered some mulching hay if any is needed to repair trails, and Adam and Harvey volunteered their services and possibly some steel framing for repairs. Matt and the Furlongs both have small dump trucks if needed, and Adam has a welding shop as well.

Old Business:

Terry gave an update on the on-line membership program, saying that it is now available to everyone for sign up purposes. Clubs can also set their own dues within reasonable parameters to fit the program.

Paul Hamel spoke with Fredrick Hall about the possibility of moving the club trail to a better position on his fields, but Hall is reluctant to change anything at this time.

New Business:

Ron Ferguson came in to inform us that the Claremont Beagle Club will be holding a fundraiser, selling hamburgers/hotdogs, rain or shine, on Saturday, February 17<sup>th</sup> from 10:30 am to 3:30 pm. They are welcoming all snowmobilers to stop by. Information on their fundraiser will be made available on our website and through emails, and flyers will be hung in the warming huts.

**Motion:** to have a club ride on Saturday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, providing there is adequate snow, and stopping by the Claremont Beagle Club for chow, as made by Matt and seconded by Bill. Passed unanimously.

Bill said there were several snowmobile tracks that were cutting across an individual's private property down on East Shore Rd, which was upsetting the property owner. Terry said he would give Bill some "No Snowmobiles" signs to erect and hopefully stop this practice immediately.

Also, Terry instructed Bill to go ahead and write out the \$150.00 check to Camp Sno-Mo for Easter Seals.
