Trail Assessments – Terry reported that some trails & bridges sustained moderate to heavy damage as a result of the heavy rains & flash flooding that occurred during mid-July, and some areas have not yet been inspected or assessed. The bridges at both blueberry farm on Heartbreak trail & the Rte. 5 Claremont Beagle Club are damaged. Rte. 5 near Roger Reed's, and at the 399 junction, and the bridge on Walker/Turkey Shoot Road near Heino Road need work. Also the triangle trail leading up from Crescent Lake Road and other sections are in need of repair.

Grant for Bridge replacement – The \$6,250 grant to repair the bridge at Nick Taylor's is available to use, but lumber prices have been unreasonably high, but have been dropping finally. Nick Taylor will coordinate gathering quotes for Lumber.
